Would you like to know how to use your data to increase the perceived level of empowerment among families with infants and toddlers with disabilities in your region? The goal of the family survey is to answer the following three questions:

- (1) How well has the EDN program helped parents understand their rights,
- (2) How well has EDN helped parents in the program effectively communicate their child's needs, and
- (3) How well had EDN helped children served develop and learn?

Dr. Haidee Bernstein and Dr. Batya Elbaum will facilitate a deeper understanding of your data and new ways to analyze 6 years of trend data to foster program improvement. Learn Family Centered Practices:

- Find out about the daily lives of the families with whom you work in order to partner meaningfully to help them identify IFSP/IEP goals
- Provide family consultation to enhance and support family skills
- Teach key, generalizable skills to parents and family members, such as
 - incidental teaching
 - contingent observation
 - how to rate their child's progress
- How to reframe – and not be judgmental (use of language)
- How to provide informational support
- How to ensure material and emotional support
