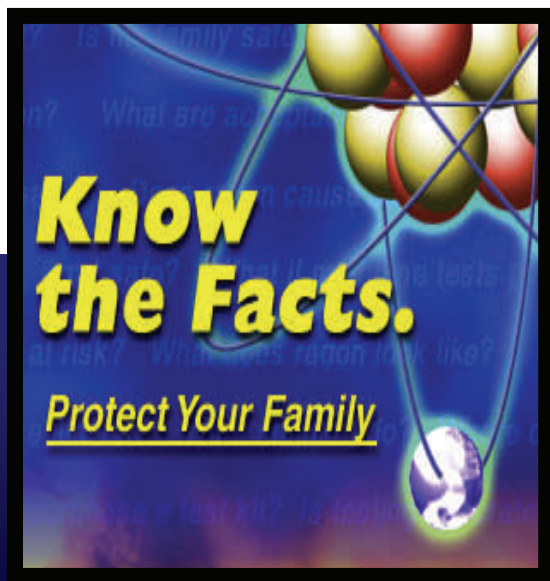


# QUICK FACTS:

- ☒ Testing your home for radon is EASY and INEXPENSIVE!
- ☒ **FIX** your home if your radon level is 4.0 picocuries per liter (pCi/L) or higher.
- ☒ Radon levels less than 4.0 pCi/L still pose a risk and may be reduced.
- ☒ Testing is done by using a short-term test kit (2-90 days) or a long-term test kit (more than 90 days). A long-term test is more likely to reflect your home's year-round average.

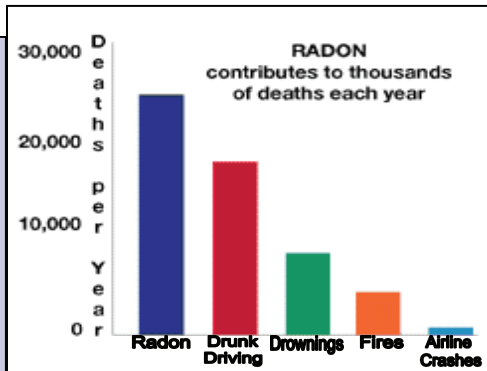

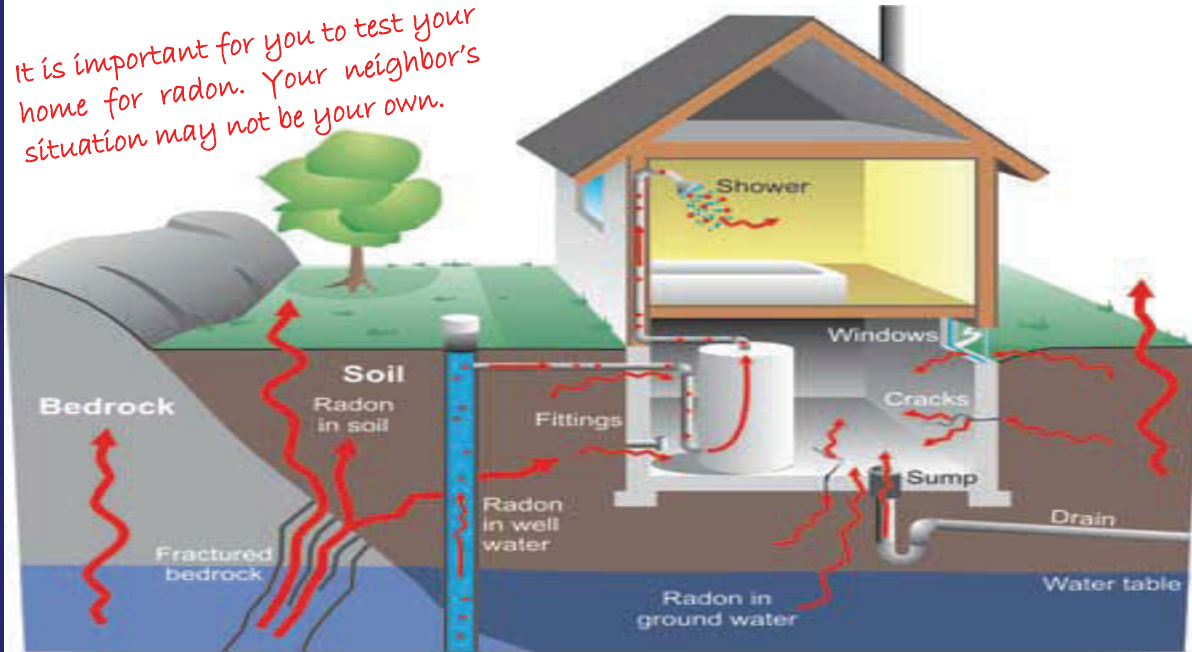
# Basic Radon Facts

- ☠ Radon is a cancer-causing, radioactive gas. It is undetectable to human senses (sight, taste, or smell).
- ☠ According to the US EPA, radon is estimated to cause thousands of lung cancer deaths each year.
- ☠ In **NEBRASKA**, 1 out of every 2 homes tested has high radon levels (above 4.0 pCi/L).
- ☠ It is recommended to test your home for radon every 2 years.

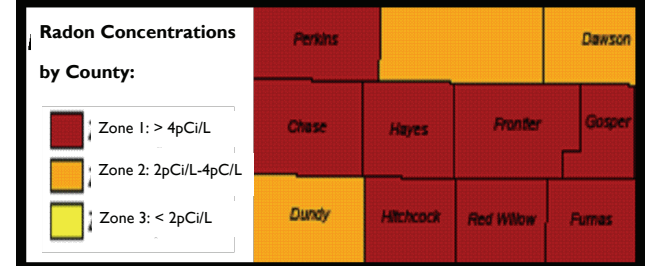
