## **Respite Providers Taking Care of Caregivers**

Nebraska Respite Southwest Area would like to recognize the outstanding efforts their respite providers give to the people they serve. According to the National Family Caregivers Association, in any given year over 65 million people provide some level of caregiving services.

Respite providers give family caregivers a break from the daily tasks of caring for a loved one. Often caregiving is a 24 hour/7 days a week commitment. Many people do not realize they need a break or that help is available through the respite network. Grandparents often fall into this category, as they may be raising grandchildren with various disorders, such as: autism spectrum, reactive attachment (RAD), attention deficit hyperactive (ADHD), bipolar, and aggressive or disruptive behaviors. Children with individualized education plans (IEP) may also qualify for respite care.

"Finding providers to give caregivers a break is an ongoing effort," states Helena T Janousek, Respite Coordinator, SW Area. "Our office can assist in the process to become a respite provider. Call the office at 308-345-4990 to get additional information."
