McCook – daily, 8:00-4:00 pm at 404 West 10<sup>th</sup> Street

Anyone two months and older are invited to get their vaccinations. Walk-ins are welcome. "School will be out soon and summer will fly by fast. This is a great time to get your child's immunizations caught up", states Melissa Propp, RN Public Health Nurse.

Persons with no insurance or under-insured may qualify for the state-funded vaccine. Call the office for qualifications at 345-4223. Both state funded and private vaccines are available at these clinics. Insurance billing and cash payment options are available to those who do not qualify for the free vaccine.
