Vaccines for Children Public Clinics Offered in June

Southwest Nebraska Public Health Department (SWNPHD) will be offering Vaccines for Children at public clinics in May.

Locations include:

Curtis – Monday, June 11th, 4:30-5:30 pm at Medicine Valley High School Ogallala – Thursday, June 21st, 12:30-1:30 pm at Prairie View Elementary School, Superintendent's office

McCook – *daily, 8:00-4:00 pm at 404 West 10th Street* **Other locations:** check with your local health care provider

Anyone two months and older are invited to get their vaccinations. Walk-ins are welcome. "Travel shots are also available. Call the office to get additional information regarding the travel shots," states Melissa Propp, Public Health Nurse.

Persons with no insurance or under-insured may qualify for the state-funded vaccine. Call the office for qualifications at 345-4223. Both state funded and private vaccines are available at these clinics. Insurance billing and cash payment options are available to those who do not qualify for the free vaccine.
