New DHM Guidance and Furnas County's Ninth COVID-19 Case

Southwest Nebraska Public Health Department (SWNPHD) has moved into Phase 2 of reopening with Directed Health Measures (DHM) that will be in effect June 1st to June 30th, 2020. Additional guidance regarding sports has also been received and an informational planning tool is in place to assist residents of southwest Nebraska when planning events.

Sports Guidance:

Sports are divided into three groups: contact, limited contact, and no contact. Phase 2 allows practices for limited contact and no contact sports including baseball, softball, and volleyball to begin June 1st, and games starting June 18th. Contact sports like basketball, tackle football, soccer, and wrestling remain prohibited. Rodeos are permitted if they follow DHM requirements for gatherings, and school gyms and weight rooms are now permitted to follow DHM requirements for gyms and fitness centers.

Event Planning Tool:

SWNPHD encourages all event coordinators of gatherings and events of any size to complete the COVID-19 Event and Gathering Safety Plan as it provides resources to host safe and successful gatherings. If the venue holds 500 or more people, SWNPHD will review the plan and confirm it is approved or suggest changes within 5 business days.

Additionally, SWNPHD has been notified of one more person from the health district that has tested positive for COVID-19. This case is a female in her seventies in Furnas County, related to community spread. This brings the total to 19 confirmed cases in the health district, 9 of which have been in Furnas County. News releases for confirmed COVID-19 cases will be sent out weekly, moving away from daily.
