Vaccines for Children Public Clinics in November

Southwest Nebraska Public Health Department (SWNPHD) will be offering Vaccines for Children at public clinics in November. Flu shots will also be available at these clinics now that flu season has started. Anyone two months of age and older are invited to get their vaccinations.

Locations include:

Hayes Center- Tuesday, November 1st, 4:00-5:00 pm at Hayes Center Elementary School. This clinic will be flu shots only.

Curtis – Monday, November 14th, 4:30-5:30 pm at Medicine Valley High School.

Trenton – Tuesday, November 15th, 3:30-4:30 pm at Hitchcock County High School Library. **Ogallala** – Thursday, November 17th, 12:30-1:30 pm Mountain Time at Prairie View School. **Ogallala Office**– weekly every Thursday, 8:00 am-4:00 pm MT, walk-in's welcome. Also 4:00-6:00 pm MT by appointment only. *Please note the new address: 418 North Spruce Suite A in Ogallala.* **McCook** – daily Monday-Friday, 8:00-4:00 pm based upon the nurse availability, at 404 West 10th Street (one block north of Arby's).

Other locations: check with your local healthcare provider or local pharmacy.

November clinics are very busy. SWNPHD encourages those interested in vaccination to call to schedule an appointment. Walk-ins are welcome, but priority will be given to those with a scheduled appointment.

Vaccines for Children is funded in whole with federal and DHHS funds. Children with no insurance, under-insured, Medicaid, Native American or Native Alaskan qualify for state-funded vaccine. Adults who are uninsured or under-insured may also qualify for state funded vaccine. Call the office for qualifications at 308-345-4223. Both state-funded and private vaccines are available at these clinics. Insurance billing and cash or credit card payment options are available to those who do not qualify for the state-funded vaccine.
